As part of our ongoing commitment to the safety and well-being of all our beneficiaries, Bokamoso Education Trust is strengthening our safeguarding practices to ensure they remain robust, proactive, and aligned with international best standards.

We are proud to be doing this in partnership with **The Guardian**, a leading organisation in the field of safeguarding. The Guardian brings extensive expertise in child protection and the prevention of harm, particularly within schools, nonprofits, and community organisations. Their work focuses on creating safe environments for children, young people, and vulnerable adults through the development of tailored frameworks, clear policies, and practical training.

Together with The Guardian, we have co-developed a safeguarding framework designed to equip all our staff, mentors, volunteers, and partners with the tools and confidence to uphold our duty of care. This initiative reflects our belief that safeguarding is not just a policy—it's a shared responsibility and a core part of how we support every young person in our programme to thrive. We hope that in raising the standards of safeguarding Bokamoso's children, other institutions involved in childcare, would feel compelled to follow suit.
