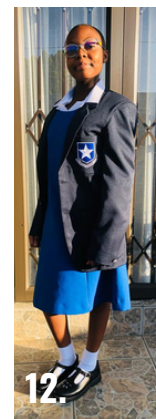
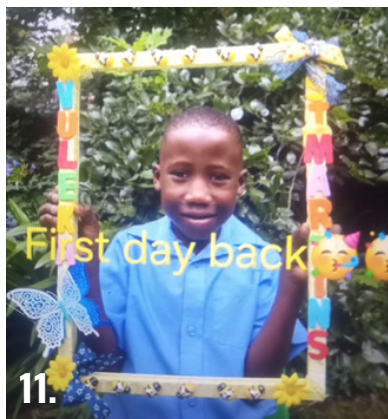
Our beneficiaries are excited to be back at school and are settling into their new routines well.

Our popular Bokamoso Golf Day (Johannesburg) is booked! Be sure to save the date in your diary - **03 August 2026!**

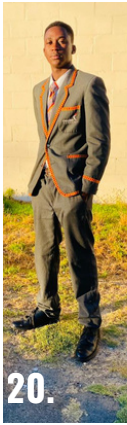
